HOW DO I BECOME A FANNIE BATTLE CAROLER?

1. Call the day home at (615)-228-6745.
2. Leave your name, number and where you would like to carol. You can even request a specific street or streets.
3. A Carol volunteer will contact you to verify the street or streets and make sure it is not already being caroled. A time will be arranged to deliver your caroling bags loaded with everything you need: song sheets, announcement envelopes, and instructions.
4. Get your group together, decide which evening you will be caroling, and deliver the letters a few days before the caroling date to let neighbors know you're coming.
5. After you've caroled, contact the Carol volunteer to arrange a time for returning your caroling bags and donations.
6. Have fun caroling, and make it a yearly event!
